

NOTICE: MID REPORTING REQUIREMENTS

Every customs entry filed in the U.S. requires a manufacturer identification number (MID) to identify the source of the goods. When the goods are textiles, apparel, or other articles which are now or were previously subject to quotas, Customs now requires the MID number to reflect the name and location of the manufacturer where the origin of the goods was conferred (the actual manufacturer of the product). This cannot be a trading company, a third party who previously purchased the goods, IT MUST BE THE ACTUAL MANUFACTURING LOCATION.

CUSTOMS HAS ANNOUNCED THAT THE FILING OF ENTRIES WITH INCORRECT MIDS WILL BE CONSIDERED TO BE A VIOLATION OF THE LAW, WHICH IS PUNISHABLE BY THE ASSESSMENT OF SUBSTANTIAL CIVIL PENALTIES.

Your invoice includes textile products (fabric/apparel/shoes/luggage or other items) that are covered by this provision. We need to have you verify the name and complete address of the actual manufacturer of these products. If more than one – please list each with the products that they produced. Your entry cannot be filed with Customs until we have this information.
